

## Measurements - Continued: (There is a picture for each measurement.) 2. Front edge of upper landing to front inches edge of bottom step (Similar to but not exactly the same as measurement #1.) Let's get two step/tread measurements: (Note that a carpenter square or any other measurement tool with a right angle is very handy for these measurements.) Close-up of steps 3. Rise inches 4. Net Tread inches If your step has a slight overhang, measure from the tip of the overhang **Net Tread** 5. Width of staircase? inches Width of staircase **5** What is at the top and bottom of staircase? (Possible obstructions - things that can't move doors, door-less entries, halls, etc.) 6. Distance from BOTTOM step to obstruction? inches What is the obstruction? 6 7. Distance from TOP step to obstruction? inches What is the obstruction?
